VEHICLE STOCK CONTROL (VSC)

Continuous inventory control of dealer networks.

BUSINESS CHALLENGE

The financial entities of automotive manufacturers have the role of financing their dealer networks in order to push sales. This represents a vast amount of money circulating in the dealer network, a burden that carries a significant financial cost. Contractual obligations and payment due dates need to be strictly followed up and controlled in order to minimize and prevent losses.

What is Vehicle Stock Control (VDT) ?

Vehicle Stock Control (VSC), or Floor Plan Auditing, is a service designed to help financial controllers within vehicle manufacturing companies to continuously monitor the stock of vehicles in dealers' yards, as well as related contract payments and documents according to the client's audit criteria.

 - Collect data and upload to Bureau Veritas server

FAQ :

• Can VSC be an outsourcing service?

Often, clients in this sector have their own audit/controller structure. Its tasks can be partly or totally outsourced to the Bureau Veritas team.

• Is it a safe process ?

As with all Bureau Veritas services, confidentiality is contractually assured to safeguard the information processed and to optimize efficiency of the operations. Audit scheduling is totally confidential and is communicated to auditors only a few hours in advance.

• How often are the audits performed?

Normally clients request an update every 2 weeks, or even more frequently, to ensure that the dealership network information stays fresh. Dealers who have several branches, and who have vehicles away from the authorized locations, are inspected within the same day.
