Eligibility Criteria

- Applicable to all kind of businesses, organizations and event
- Organization must meet all national, provincial and local waste and recycling laws and regulations
- Establish clear zero waste management system which shall consist of "planning, implementation, evaluation and improvement" cycle
- Achieved auditable waste diversion rate corresponding to the level of certificate

Background and Rationale

Circular Economy is an economic system aimed at eliminating waste and the continual use of resources. This regenerative approach is in contrast to the traditional linear economy, which has a "take, make, dispose" model of production.

Therefore, Bureau Veritas establish "**Zero Waste Management**" scheme to helps corporates to show and demonstrate their commitment level with the environment and support Circular Economy by minimizing their wastes to incinerator or landfill.

What is "Zero Waste Management?"

"Zero Waste Management" is complementary to ISO 14001, Bureau Veritas Solution and can be applied to all kind of companies and organizations that searching to show their commitment.

Concept of Zero Waste

Zero Waste definition is "The conservation of all resources by means of responsible production, consumption, reuse, and recovery of products, packaging, and materials without burning and with no discharges to land, water, or air that threaten the environment or human health." (Zero Waste International Alliance, 2018)

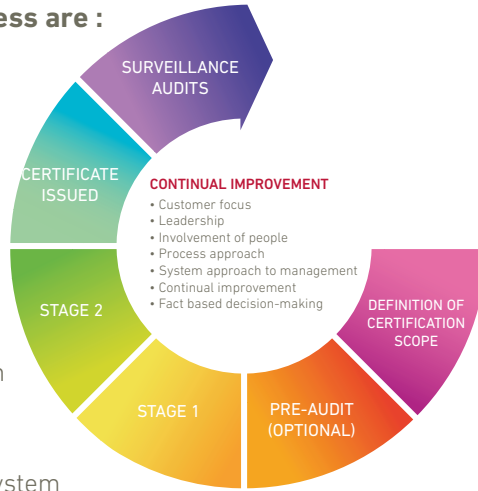
While Zero Waste Management certificate aims to encourage organization to minimize discharged mass by divert this mass to beneficial use by method such as reuse, recycle, repair, refurbishment, material recovery or adopt strategic approach such as redesign and reduce.



OUR CERTIFICATION PROCESS

Key steps in our certification process are :

- **Definition of certification scope.**
- **Pre-audit (optional):** gap analysis and diagnosis of your current position against standard.
- **Certification audit** performed in 2 stages :
 - **Stage 1.** Readiness review performed to verify that the organization is ready for certification
 - **Stage 2.** Evaluation of implementation, including the effectiveness, of the management system of the organization
- A **certificate** valid for 3 years is issued upon satisfactory results of stage 2 audit.
- **Surveillance audits** to verify that the management system continues to fulfill the requirements of the standard and monitor the continual improvement.
- **Re-certification** after 3 years to confirm the continued conformance and effectiveness of the management system as a whole.
